than we had raised last year at the same Event. This was our 3rd year of giving and our hope is to continue with this Event with Foundation monies we raise annually.

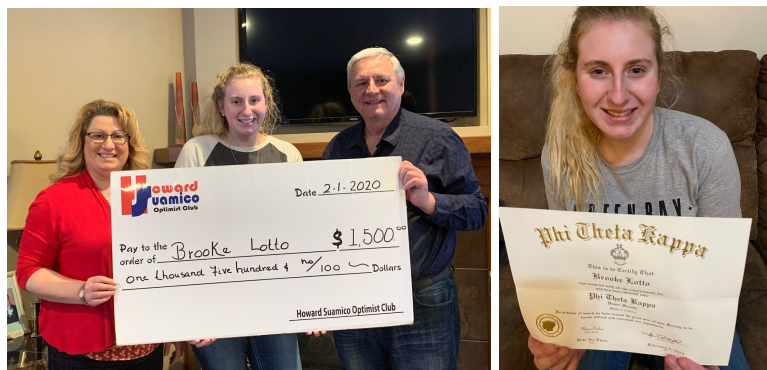

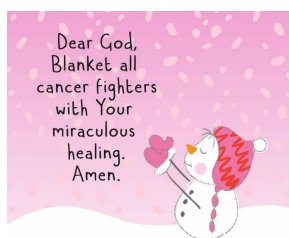
as Lieutenant Governors supporting Governor Dan O'Leary. Thank you to all 3 of you for accepting the rose and serving our Youth another year!!!!
